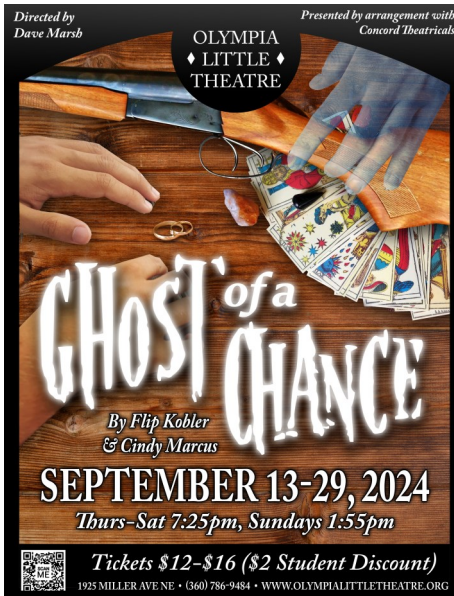

A Party to Murder

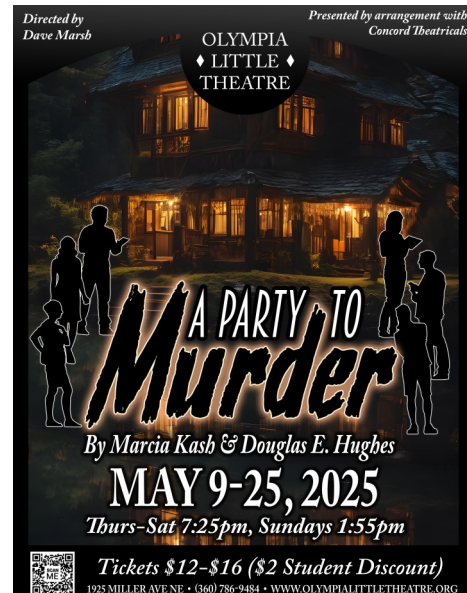
